**1. What if I'm not enrolled when funds are distributed?**

If you are not actively enrolled in July 2026, Fairview Housing Partners may reclaim the funds and award them to another eligible applicant.

**2. Do I have to currently live in a Fairview-affiliated property?**

Yes. You must be a resident in good standing at an eligible community, confirmed by your property manager.

**3. Do I have to be enrolled in school to apply?**

Yes. Applicants must be enrolled in high school, technical school, college, or university and must provide proof of current enrollment.

**4. What if I'm accepted to college but haven't started yet?**

You may still apply, but you must be actively enrolled at the time scholarship funds are disbursed in July 2026.

**5. Do I need a minimum GPA to apply?**

A cumulative 3.0 GPA is preferred, but students are encouraged to apply even if their GPA is below 3.0, as applications may still be considered based on overall strength of the application.

**6. Can GED students apply?**

Yes. Applicants who hold a GED and plan to attend a technical school or college may apply with proof of enrollment.

**7. What documents are required for the application?**

In addition to a completed application, applicants must submit required materials such as transcripts (or GED), proof of enrollment, a typed essay, and a letter of recommendation. Incomplete applications will not be considered.

**8. Do I need a letter of recommendation?**

Yes. One signed letter is required from a teacher, counselor, advisor, coach, professor, or supervisor (not a relative).

**9. If I have already received other scholarships or financial awards, should I still apply?**

Yes. Applicants may still apply even if they have received other scholarships or financial assistance. However, if your tuition is already paid in full and you no longer have a remaining balance, Fairview Housing Partners may review the award and may reclaim the scholarship funds to support another eligible student in need.

**10. How are scholarship funds paid out? Will I receive the money directly?**

No. Scholarship funds are paid directly to the student's school and may only be used for qualified educational expenses such as tuition and required fees.

**11. Will scholarship recipients be asked to participate in interviews or promotional materials?**

Possibly. Awardees may be invited to participate in video interviews, photography, or storytelling efforts for scholarship promotion.

**12. Who is Tiana Rogers and what is Today's Resident Services (TRS)?**
